Retinal, also known as Vitamin A1 or axerophthol, is a fat-soluble, essential vitamin. Retinal is sensitive to light, air and oxidizing agents and serves the organism as a radical scavenger. Due to the sensitivity of retinal to acids and oxidizing agents the more stable retinal esters or the aldehyde form (retinal) are mostly used in cosmetics.
